





## **Preparing Your Application**

#### Check the brochure and make sure you qualify for:

- All Programmes page 3
- Au Pair Extraordinaire page 7
- EduCare in America page 10

#### Gather together the following items:

- Copies of the latest school, academic and/or vocational certificates or diplomas you hold, or a letter from your school/college verifying the dates you attended and the qualifications you gained.
  - Au Pair Extraordinaire applicants must supply a copy of the appropriate childcare qualification or a reference confirming their experience.
- A copy of your full driving licence
- A criminal record check certificate
- A copy of your passport

#### Before your interview you also need to:

- Complete the application form.
- Write a Dear Host Family Letter.
- Provide photographs.
- · Collect a minimum of three references.
- Arrange an interview.
- · Arrange a medical check up.

#### **Dear Host Family Letter:**

You will need to write a letter to tell your host family all about yourself. Include the reasons why you want to be an au pair in the USA, the children you have taken care of and the activities you have enjoyed with them. Write about your family and your relationship with them. Provide examples of qualities you have which will help you become part of an American host family providing caring and responsible childcare. Give as much detail as you can so that the American host family reading your letter gets a sense of your personality and the kind of person you are. Your 'Dear Host Family Letter' is one of the most important parts of the application ... please spend time writing a great letter.

- Use no less than 600 words on no more than 2 pages of white A4 paper.
- Write clearly in black ink.
- Write your name at the top of each page.
- Make sure that you leave a 2cm margin on all sides.

#### Photographs - 2 pages only

The photographs you choose must show you together with the children you have cared for, you with your family and friends in the places you live or frequently visit. For your passport sized photograph use a light background and remember to smile!

- First glue the passport sized photograph in the top right hand corner of the first page.
- Then arrange the 4 to 6 photographs over the 2 white A4 pages do not overlap or staple them.
- Next to each photo, in black ink, explain who is in the picture and what you are doing.
- Write your name at the top of each page.
- Make sure you leave a 2cm margin on all sides.

#### **References:**

You will need to collect a minimum of 3 references. References should be completed on the enclosed Au Pair in America reference forms. Photocopy the 3 different types of forms as required so that you have 1 sheet for each reference. **EduCare** candidates must submit an additional academic reference as well as the childcare and character reference.

- At least 1 of the references must be a childcare reference from either an employer or childcare teacher – be sure to use the correct form.
- Immediate family members may not complete a reference.
- All references must be translated into English on one of these forms with the original attached.
- We encourage you to submit as many childcare and character references as possible.

#### Arranging an Interview:

If you live in Australia, Germany or South Africa, send your completed application to 'attention: DEPT APP' at the appropriate address shown on the back of the brochure. If you live in another country, contact the nearest Au Pair in America interviewer to arrange an interview. Bring your completed application to the interview.

#### Tips to maximise your placement changes:

- · Write neatly with black ink!
- Be accurate with your details!
- Be honest about your experience and health!
- Understand what you are signing!
- Photocopy the agreement and application documents for your own reference.

#### Read this agreement carefully and sign and date below.

Last Name

In consideration of you, the American Institute for Foreign Study Inc., herein after referred to as 'AIFS', accepting me for their Au Pair in America, Au Pair Extraordinaire or EduCare in America programme, I hereby undertake and agree as follows:

First Name

- I. will complete all visa and screening requirements in accordance with the instructions given and will be responsible for obtaining a valid passport and complying with all vaccination and immunisation requirements.
  - b) I will only accept a placement with a host family whom I have interviewed with personally by telephone. I will review all Pre-departure Training materials and attend all sessions during the Orientation programme.
  - c) I will be present in good time for all flights or other transportation provided or arranged by AIFS. AIFS will not provide or be responsible for alternative transportation except in the case of illness or accident in accordance with its group insurance policy.
  - d) I will abide by all appropriate regulations and instructions of the US Government and obey all applicable laws.
- II. a) As a participant on the Au Pair in America or Au Pair Extraordinaire programme, I will provide childcare up to 45 hours per week and not more than 10 hours per day, for a period not exceeding the 12 months granted under the terms of my visa. As a participant on the EduCare in America programme, I will provide childcare up to 30 hours per week and not more than 10 hours per day, for a period not exceeding the 12 months granted under the terms of my visa.
  - b) I will carry out my childcare and other responsibilities to the host family to the best of my ability and with due respect and will take full advantage of the cultural opportunities and will fulfil the educational requirements in accordance with the rules and guidelines set out in the brochure and applicants' handbook.
  - c) At the end of my stay I will return to my home country on or before the expiry of my 'duration of stay' as determined by US Immigration and will not attempt to return subsequently to the United States without a valid and current US visa.
  - d) I understand that programme flights will depart from and return to designated airports, so I am responsible for any costs prior to departure and upon my return. I must also make my own way to my designated US return airport at the end of the programme in time for my return flight and pay any transportation costs from my family to the airport. AIFS is not responsible for airline baggage costs or airport taxes.
  - e) I understand the support system provided by the London and Connecticut offices, and affiliate offices if appropriate, and Community Counsellors network. I will maintain monthly contact with my Community Counsellor. I will co-operate fully with those supervising the programme on my behalf for AIFS and I agree to abide by any reasonable instructions they may give me.
  - f) I will not accept any form of paid employment in the USA during my stay other than within my duties as a programme participant with my host family.
  - g) While living with my host family I will be responsible for all personal debts, such as telephone calls. In the event of an automobile accident, I may be liable for up to, but no more than, US\$500 of the insurance deductible.
  - $\hbox{h)} \quad \text{As detailed on my application, I certify that I have successfully completed my secondary school studies/training.}$
  - i) I declare that I have never been charged with or convicted of a criminal offence.
  - j) I declare that I have not previously participated in an au pair programme in the United States.
  - k) I understand that my application and contents herein cannot be returned to me at any time.
- III. I understand that failing to provide full and accurate responses to the questions asked in this application, on the medical report form, at interview and on all ancillary documents may result in the rejection of my application or termination from the programme. I hereby warrant that the information I have given in the application form completed by me is accurate. I also declare that all qualifications gained and certificates and references provided, including photocopies are genuine.
- IV. I agree that I will perform my duties as an au pair or EduCare companion to the best of my ability and indemnify AIFS, its staff, agents and all affiliated organisations from any damages, losses or claims resulting from my participation in the programme.
  - I unconditionally release AIFS, its staff, agents and all affiliated organisations, from any claims for damage, injury, loss, or expense of any nature in connection with my participation on the programme, including any losses arising from the use of any vehicle or from any act or omission by any host family, airline or other common carrier, or other firm, agency, company or individual, unless the loss is caused by the gross negligence of AIFS.
- V. I agree that AIFS may take such actions as it considers necessary regarding my health and safety during my time on the programme, including securing medical treatment for me and transporting me to my home country. I release AIFS from any liability relating to the medical care received, and agree to pay for any medical or transportation expenses that are not covered by insurance.
- VI. I understand that, in the event of late cancellation from the programme (after the visa application form has been issued) Au Pair in America and AIFS reserves the right to charge a US\$200 cancellation fee.
- VII. a) I understand that as a participant on the Au Pair in America or Au Pair Extraordinaire programme, if for any reason I do not complete the full 12 month term of the programme, or the required educational hours, I shall forfeit the Completion Payment and not be entitled to any refund of the Good Faith Payment, the Au Pair in America placement fee, insurance costs or any other supplemental payments for any ancillary services.
  - b) I understand that as a participant on the EduCare in America programme, if for any reason I do not complete the full 12 month term of the programme, or the required educational hours, I shall forfeit the EduCare in America placement fee, programme fees or any other supplemental payments for any ancillary services.
- VIII. I confirm that I have read and understand the Au Pair in America brochure and guidelines and agree that its terms are deemed to be incorporated in this agreement.
- IX. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Connecticut. I agree that any dispute with AIFS, its staff, agents and all affiliated organisations that is not settled informally will be submitted to binding arbitration, to be conducted in substantial accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association. The location of the arbitration and identity of the arbitrator will be decided by mutual agreement, with the costs to be shared equally between the parties, and the decision of the arbitrator shall be final. By signing this agreement, I understand that I am giving up my right to have any claim against AIFS, Inc. and its affiliated organisations decided in Court before a judge or jury.
